

ORDER
FIRE and SMOKING PROHIBITIONS
PRESCOTT NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (a) & (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads, and trails described in this Order within the Prescott National Forest.

- (1). **BUILDING, MAINTAINING, ATTENDING OR USING A FIRE, CAMPFIRE OR STOVE FIRE. 36 CFR 261.52 (a)**
- (2). **SMOKING. 36 CFR 261.52 (c)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons using pressurized liquid or gas stoves.
- (2) Campfires are permitted by persons in developed campgrounds or picnic grounds and the fire is within the grills provided.
- (3) Smoking is permitted by persons in enclosed vehicles, buildings, and in developed recreation sites.
- (4) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (5) Persons with a permit authorizing the prohibited act or omission.

AREA AFFECTED BY THIS ORDER:

All National Forest System lands within the boundaries of the Prescott National Forest.

This **ORDER** becomes effective **0800, Friday, July 1, 2005** and will remain in effect until rescinded.
